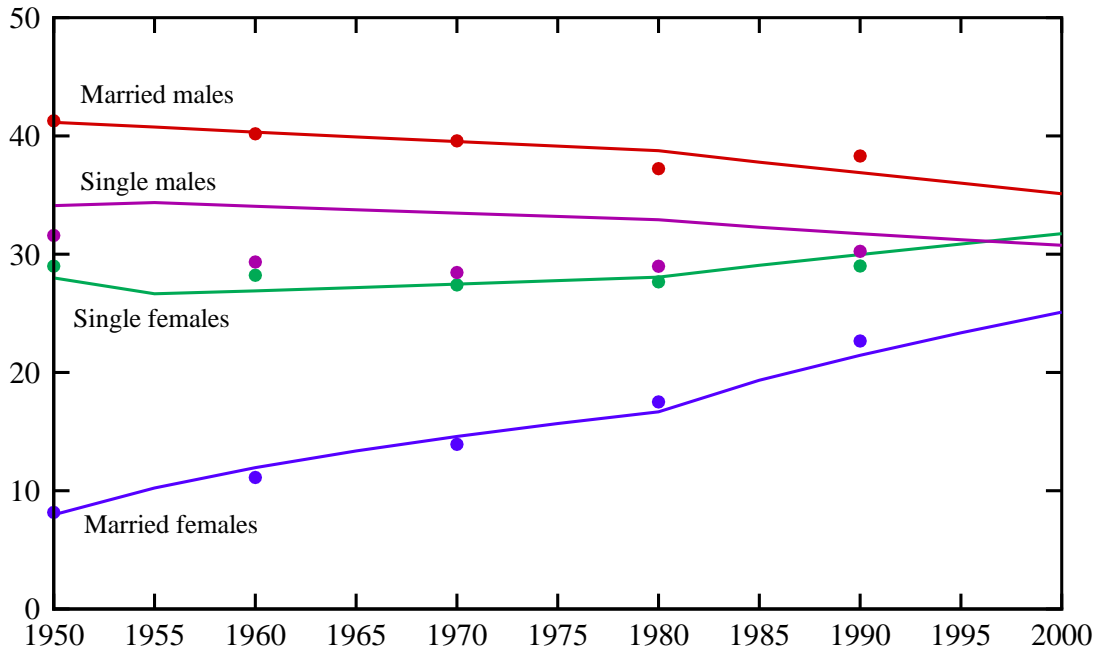
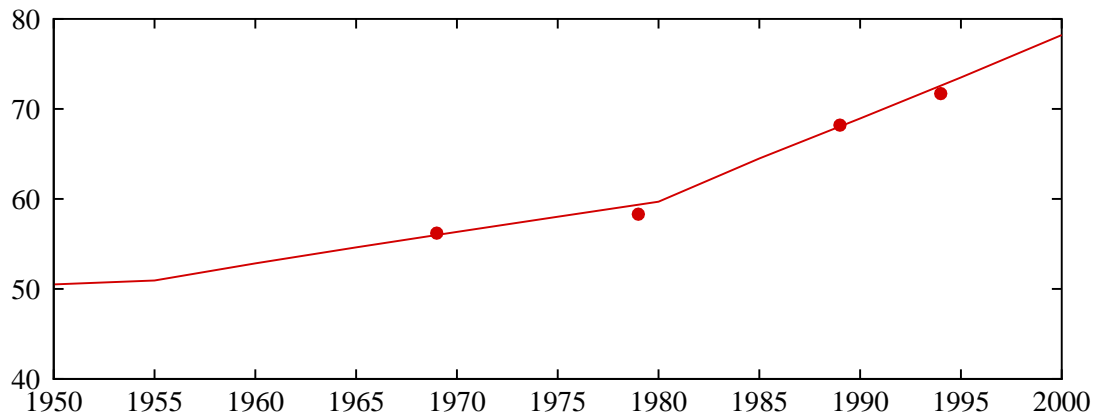


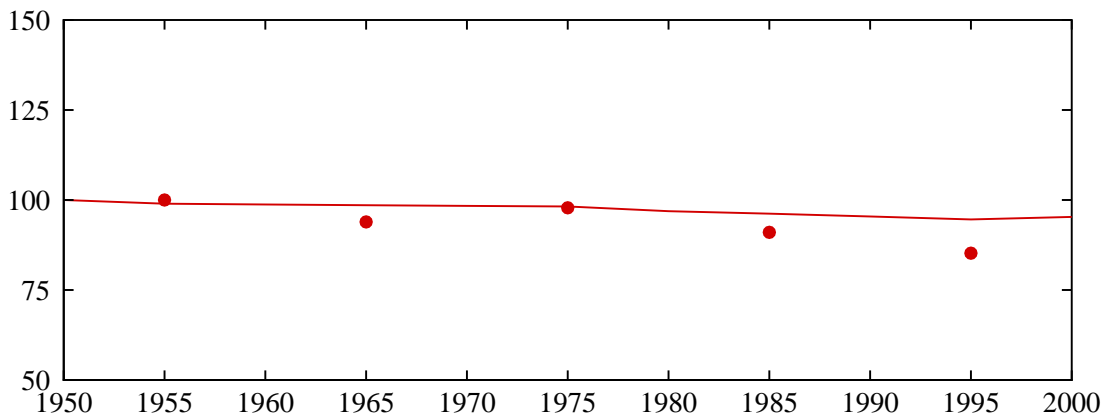

A. Market Hours of Work Per Week

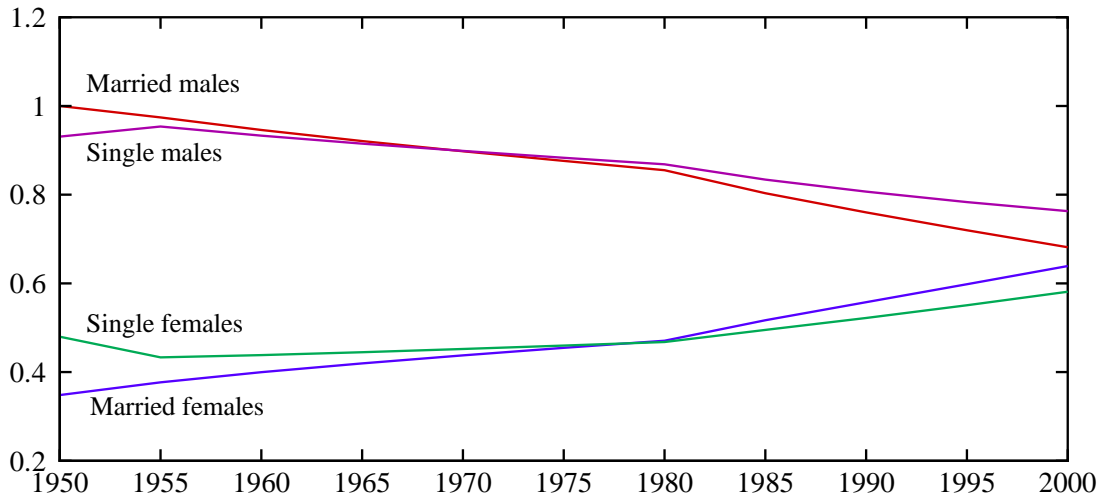


B. Ratio of Female to Male Wage Rate (%)

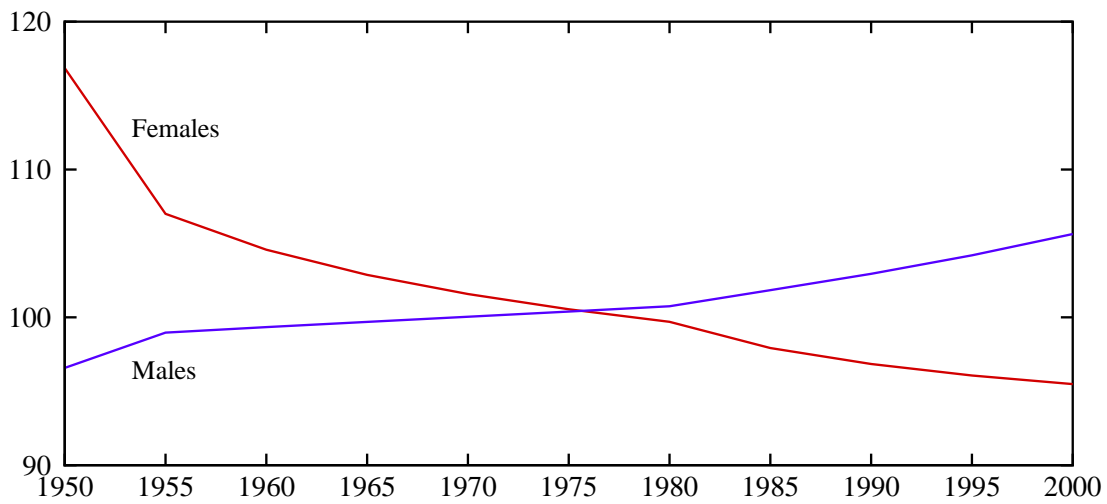


C. Ratio of Home Investment to Market Output (1950=100)

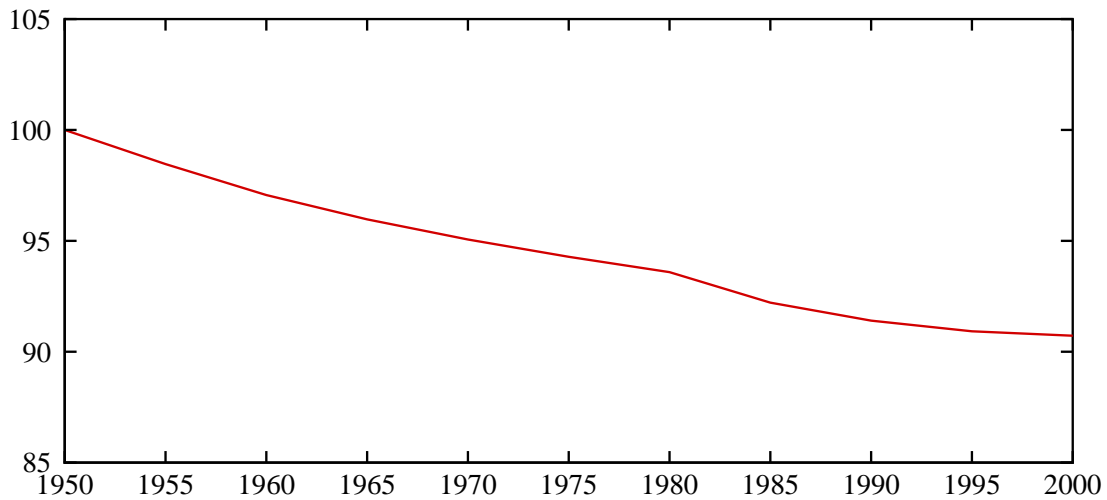
