## Constructed Series: Description

- C.1 Real GDP per working-age person, United States.  $(O.1 * 1000 / O.2) / (O.3 / 100)$  for 1870-2008;  
 $O.4 * C.1(2008) / O.4(2008)$  for 2009-2010 <sup>1</sup>
- C.2-C.5 Population growth rate by stages of growth (percent) <sup>2</sup>
- C.6-C.9 Share of world population by stages of growth (percent)
